FACTS	WHAT DOES ORG DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers and investors the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: • Social Security number and assets • Accounts balances and transaction history • Wire transaction instructions and risk tolerance
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons ORG chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

	for exercising any of the above rights.
	To request the personal information that has been collected about
	you or to request deletion, please call 877-523-3980.
	In response to the CCPA, to be conservative we assume accounts
	with California addresses do not want us to disclose personal
	information about you to non-affiliated third parties, except as
	permitted by Federal and California law. We also limit the sharing
	of personal information about you with our affiliates to ensure
	compliance with California privacy laws.
